Hair, Make-Up and Costume Details for Dress Rehearsals & Showcases

- **Hair**: All dancers need to have their hair **parted in the middle, slicked back into a low ponytail with an elastic that matches their hair color**. (Some dancers may have specific hair accessories that came with their costume and they can put those on over the elastic for those dances.) Dancers can choose curled or straightened hair for their ponytail, but the important thing is that the hair in front is neatly slicked back with gel and hairspray to ensure it stays slicked back the entire time while dancing.

- **No Polish/Jewelry/Glitter/Straps**: No glitter, jewelry, toe nail polish or fingernail polish is allowed. Also, no bra straps or underwear, or underwear lines can show. Please make sure dancers try on their costumes ahead of time. Please make sure dancers are secure. If they need to wear a bra, they need to wear one that does not show at all.
- **Costumes**: Please make sure that all of their costume items are in perfect condition, clean and wrinkle free. Please write their name or initials somewhere hidden from the audience on each part of their costume so it will not be lost or mixed up with their teammates. Please see the specific costumes details below for each class to ensure they have what they need.

*Note: If your dancer needs black dance shorts and/or tan dance paws for their class, they can be purchased through Dance Crew for \$25 each. If you need to order some, please be sure to email us this week to do so.

- **Make-Up**: Dancers need to have their own make-up on: foundation, red shade of lipstick, pink shade of blush, black eye liner and black mascara. Eye shadow needs to be white/cream highlight shade of shadow for under the brow and lid and brown or grey/black shade of shadow for crease of the eye. Some classes and teams need specific Halloween make-up for their dances. Please be sure to read through your dancer's class details below.

* Competition dancers do competition team make-up.

Costume & Make-Up Details by Class

Dance Combo Ages 4-6 “Monster Mash”: Their own spooky costume that they can dance in. We will let you know if any adjustments are needed - for example: pinning it shorter for safety, or adding leggings/dance shorts underneath. Shoes: Tan jazz shoes (available at any dance wear store or Amazon).

Jazz & Contemporary Ages 7-11 “Calling All the Monsters”: Their own spooky costume that they can dance in. We will let you know if any adjustments are needed - for example: pinning it shorter for safety, or adding leggings/dance shorts underneath. Shoes: tan dance paws.

Hip Hop Ages 7-11 “Frankenstein”: Their Frankenstein shirt, with their own black pants, black socks and the darkest sneakers they already own. Their black pants can be joggers, wide leg-cargo style, or sweats as long as they are completely black, full length (no capri length) and they can dance in them. Dancers also need to wear their own black tank top tucked in to their own black dance shorts underneath so their stomach doesn't show while dancing.

Jazz & Contemporary Ages 12+ “Tainted Dolls”: Doll dress over bloomer shorts with tan dance paws.
Make-up: doll make-up and instructions will be given out at practice. Please ensure dancers keep their make-up supplies in their make-up bag inside their dance bag.
Dancers will also need to have their own make-up remover (or facial lotion) and cloths (or toilet paper) for makeup changes and touch-ups.

Hip Hop Ages 12+ “Ghostface”: Their black hoodie and Ghostface mask, with their own black pants, black socks and the darkest sneakers they already own. Their black pants can be joggers, wide leg-cargo style, or sweats as long as they are completely black, full length (no capri length) and they can dance in them. Dancers also need to wear their own black tank top tucked in to their own black dance shorts underneath so their stomach doesn't show while dancing.

Dynamite Team – “Alice Broke”: Their blue dress and hair accessory with tan dance paws.

Lil Hops – “Demons”: Their black costume cross tank, black kimono top with silver and silver belt accessory, over their black warm-up pants and hat (we will keep their hats and have them ready for them) with their own black socks and the darkest sneakers they already own. Dancers also need to wear their own black tank top tucked in to their own black dance shorts underneath.

Ignite – “Untold Stories”: Their blue dress, 2 rhinestone barrettes with tan dance paws. Wear one barrette on each side near ponytail.

Fusion – “Hollow Heart”: Their black dress, rhinestone earrings with tan dance paws.

Kryptonite – “No Grave”: Cream dress with their own black dance shorts under and tan dance paws.
Make-up: No Grave make-up and instructions will be given out at practice. Please ensure dancers keep their make-up supplies in their make-up bag inside their dance bag.
Dancers will also need to have their own make-up remover (or facial lotion) and cloths (or toilet paper) for makeup changes and touch-ups.

Pack 20 – “Pennywise”: Their black hoodie with their own black pants, black socks and the darkest sneakers they already own. Their black pants can be joggers, wide leg-cargo style, or sweats as long as they are completely black, full length (no capri length) and they can dance in them. Dancers also need to wear their own black tank top tucked in to their black dance shorts underneath so their stomach doesn't show while dancing.
Make-up: Pennywise make-up and instructions will be given out at practice. Please ensure dancers keep their make-up supplies in their make-up bag inside their dance bag.
Dancers will also need to have their own make-up remover (or facial lotion) and cloths (or toilet paper) for makeup changes and touch-ups.
