## COMPANY TEAM INFORMATION PACKET 2022-2023

Congratulations to our 2022-2023 Company Team Dancers! We are looking forward to another incredible year!

All of our instructors are committed to making your dancer's experience the best possible. The following pages explain the commitment requirement, costs, practice schedule, and expectations for the year. Please be sure to read through all of the information below so that all of our dancers have a successful and enjoyable season together as a team.

### COMMITMENTS

Company Teams are full year commitments, September-June.

Attendance at all rehearsals, performances and competitions is mandatory. Company dancers should not have more than 3 absences the entire year and should never miss the week of performances or competitions. When a dancer misses a practice, it puts strain on the team because they are not able to practice partner parts, lifts, or formations with them. Missing more than the 3 practices or missing the week of a performance or competition may result in being pulled from the performances, or pulled from the routines or possibly removed from the team. Also, if a dancer does need to miss for any reason, sickness or mandatory school function, please be sure to notify us with as much notice as possible.

#### **Competitions:**

Company dancers compete at 2 competitions per year that occur on Saturdays in the months of April or May.

**Dancers need to be available the entire day on these Saturdays.** Our competition dates will be posted as soon as possible and no later than December 1<sup>st</sup>. Please be sure to not book any vacations or other plans for these months until you have these dates so that you can plan around them.

#### **Performances:**

Dancers perform at 3 Dance Crew recitals/shows, one in October, one in February and the other in June. They also have various performances that come up throughout the year such as community festivals and local events.

#### **Team Nights:**

We also have at least two fun team nights during the year.

### SCHEDULE

**Team Practice:** Practice starts the week of Sept. 6<sup>th</sup>. Our practice schedule is posted on our website. Our Fall/Winter semester runs Sept-February. Our Spring semester runs Mar-June. Our Company Teams are full year commitments Sept-June. The practice schedule may change slightly in March for spring semester but if so, it will be posted in advance.

**Additional Classes:** When looking at the schedule for your team practice times, please also look at the regular classes we offer for your dancer's age because we do encourage our company dancers to take additional classes to increase their training, progress and performing amounts.

**Ballet for Ignite and Kryptonite Teams:** Strong ballet fundamentals are critical to a dancer's overall technique quality. Ignite and Kryptonite will have ballet training the first practice of each month during their technique time. For ballet they need to wear pink tights, pink ballet shoes, black leotard and hair in a neat bun. Ballet uniform items can be purchased on your own at any dance wear store or on Amazon.

# COSTS

## MONTHLY COSTS BY TEAM(S):

Dynamite Team - \$70 per month

Shorteez and Ignite Teams - \$135 per month

Kryptonite - \$100 per month

The Crew- \$70 per month

The Crew and Kryptonite Team - \$135 per month

Additional Classes – only \$30 per month per class

Your monthly payments include: tuition for lessons each week, competition fees, recital fees, and rehearsal fee, registration, costumes (hip hop: 1 competition costume, contemporary: 2 competition costumes), all team nights, individual make-up kits, free admission for your friends and family to the two Dance Crew recitals (there is admission for spectators at the Halloween showcase), any extra practices including practice time at competitions and performances, choreography, music edits, good lucks at competitions and dress rehearsals. We have added up the total costs for the year and divided it monthly.

## OTHER COSTS:

### DANCEWEAR ITEMS:

The items listed below are dancewear items that company team dancers will use every year. These dancewear items are separate from your costumes. If they are required and you do not have them, or they do not fit anymore or are not in good condition, you will need to order new ones. We will send out an email for orders in September after the season starts.

### **Jazz/Contemporary and Hip Hop Teams**

\$70 Studio Warm-ups (Optional but highly recommended)

\$30 Studio Gym Bag (Optional but highly recommended)

### **Contemporary Teams Only**

\$25 tan turners (required -NEW! We are going to use dance half-sole turners for contemporary shoes)

\$25 tan dance paws (required - still using dance paws for jazz)

\$25 Black dance shorts (required)

Pink ballet shoes (required))

Black ballet leotard (required)

Pink ballet tights (required)

Pink or black ballet skirt (optional)

-All these items can be purchased on your own at any dancewear store or even Amazon, however, the turners, dance paws and dance shorts can be purchased through Dance Crew as well.

Optional Merchandise- optional Dance Crew merchandise such as tanks, sweats, sweatshirts, sports bras etc. will also be available throughout the year in the lobby.

Parents should also expect some additional costs such as entrance fees to competition and tickets to our Halloween Showcase which will be \$10 +ArtTix fees.

# PAYMENTS

**Monthly Payments:** Monthly payments are due on the first practice of each month. Full monthly payment amounts are due September-June regardless of how many practices in each month. In December and June we will only have class for half of the month, but during competition time we will have extra rehearsal hours to make up for it. Plus, your monthly payments include all the fees, not tuition alone.

## Payment Methods

- **Online on our Website:** To pay online, go to our website, [dancecrew.org](http://dancecrew.org). Then click on the Tuition & Fees tab at the top. There is a PayPal link with a box where you will enter the dancer's name and then hit the Pay Now button. It will then allow you to enter the amount you want to pay. Note: you do not need a PayPal account to pay online. You can select to pay with a PayPal account if you have one. Or you can select 'Do not have a PayPal account' and then it will allow you to pay with any debit or credit card.
- **Venmo:** you may also make payments through Venmo to @Dance-Crew
- **Payment Drop Box:** There is a payment drop box located in the lobby. Please make sure the dancer's name is on all check payments. There are envelopes for cash payments, please write dancer's name on the outside of the envelope.

## Late Payments

If a dancer is not current with their payment, they will not be eligible to perform or compete and may be removed from the team.

**Discount:** Receive 3% off when you pay your dancer's total tuition for the year in full up front.

**-Dance Bag:** We strongly recommend that each dancer has a gym bag with a set of all of their different practice clothes and shoes, so they can simply take their bag to class each week prepared for all classes.
